- 3. Give a vivid account of English within the British Isles, starting from **Before** English, **During** English and **After** English. (20 marks)
- 4. With examples, discuss how British English differs from American English lexically and phonologically. (20 marks)

Note: Use at least **five** examples under **four** different lexical categories (e.g. automobile, clothing, food and roads) and not less than **five** examples of the phonological features. **Do not** list the items without explaining them.
